

# Dr. Tommy Lyons Joins Staff At Cowles Clinic, Former Georgia All-American

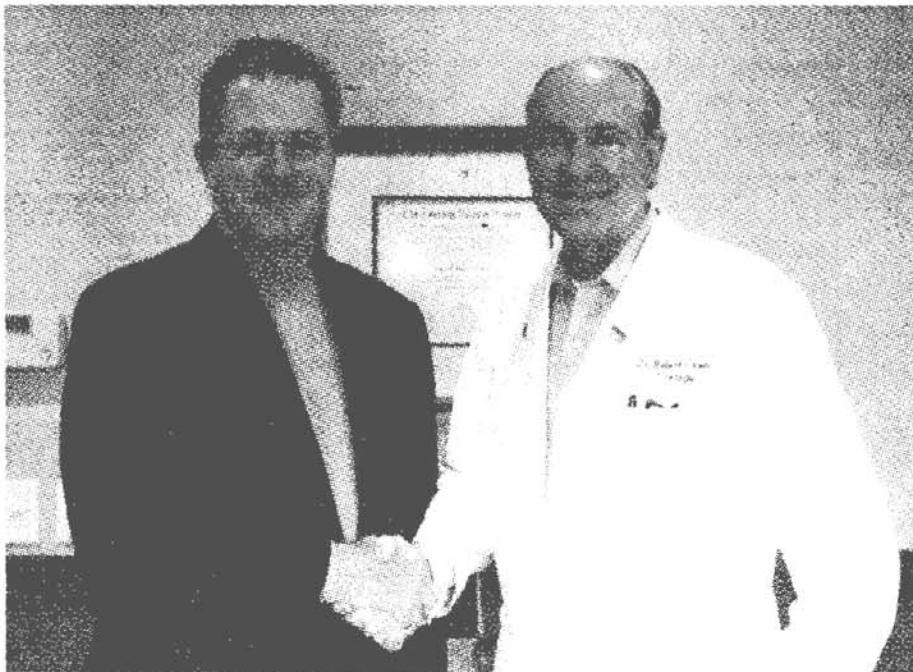
Dr. Tommy Lyons was an All-American football player at the University of Georgia in 1969 and 1970. He was also Captain of the Georgia football team and SEC champion wrestler at Georgia for three years. He later played pro-football for the Denver Broncos.

Dr. Lyons is currently in private practice as Director of The Center for Women's Care and Reproductive Surgery in Atlanta.

He is Director of Gynecologic Surgery, Chief of Surgery at Advanced Surgery Center of Georgia. Dr. Lyons is Clinical Assistant Professor at the Department of OB/GYN at Emory University Medical School in Atlanta. He is a member of HealthSouth Surgery Center, St. Joseph's Hospital and Northside-Cherokee Hospital.

Dr. Lyons holds certifications with the American Board of OB/GYN, Fellow American College OB/GYN, and Fellow American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine.

He has written thirty publications regarding various medical topics, released 19 chapters for medical publications, and made hundreds of presentations cover-
