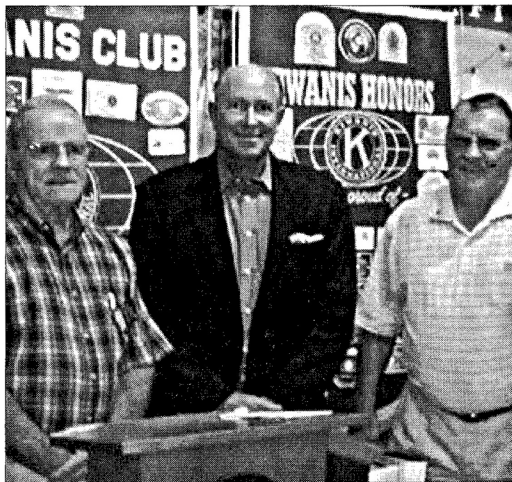


Eatonton Kiwanis Club sees exciting changes
